

MA BURSARY, UJ, 2019-2020

The Department of Philosophy at the University of Johannesburg invites outstanding young philosophers starting their MA in 2019, to apply for a two-year MA bursary.

The funding comes from a **British Academy Newton Advanced Fellowship** for a project on 'Epistemic Injustice, Reasons, and Agency', pursued in collaboration with the Department of Philosophy at the University of Kent.

The funding covers:

- tuition fees for a full time Master's degree, to be pursued at UJ starting February 2019, renewable for 2020 subject to performance
- one student assistantship

The eligible candidate will:

- have completed Honours' in Philosophy by December 2018
- have obtained 75% + average for his/her Honours' modules
- be planning to do his/ her MA in the area of epistemic injustice broadly construed, under the supervision of Prof Veli Mitova
- will have either SA citizenship or a study permit

- academic transcript
- one-page MA proposal
- CV including the names and email addresses of two referees
- a writing sample (max 10 000 words)
